Artificial Intelligence and Ethics

They say that Artificial Intelligence (AI) won't replace you in the workplace, but someone who knows how to use Al will. This is particularly true for social workers, counselors, and psychologists because we were not trained in Al, but Al is transforming our work It is becoming harder to avoid AI, yet it remains critical that we understand how Al works so that we can make informed, ethical decisions that protect both our clients and the public. We are mandated by our professional codes to do this. The widespread use of Al is recent, and it is not easy to learn all about Al and how it is being used in our professions. At the end of this course, you will understand how Al works, the different types of Al, and how it is being used in our work. You will better understand all the ethical considerations and current research findings about Al in the social work/counseling/psychology space, and walk away with frameworks on how to mitigate risk.
